DW06	Shoe Box Falls	1.5	1.5	230	91	Lovely falls and water in a flume following an intrusion into the rock; herd path is fairly well established but some care required due to variations
DW07	Boquet Rivers to Dix Inner Camp	3.5	3	980	92	A trail-less route along herd paths to a designated camp with access to the trail-less Dix region
DW05	Elizabethtown No. 4	6.7	5	1650	88	Herd path and some bushwhacking to an open knob with lovely views
JW01	Jay Wilderness	7.6	7	2910	104	Fun, quiet, in/out route with lots a great views, interesting rock and vegetation
DW08	Dix Range from Inner Camp	8.7	11	4100	94	A difficult trail-less loop using a bushwhacking climb of Dix: for very experienced trail-less hikers only
DW03	Macomb via Slide	9.0	7	3260	87	Classic well established trail-less route with a slide and rewarding views
LC05	Wright, Algonquin, and Iroquois	13.6	13.5	5390	58	Full day of glorious lake and summit views and a bit of fairly tame trail-less portion
UW03	MacNaughton	13.7	9	3650	101	Classic route to the trail-less MacNaughton that passes lovely forest and wetlands
DW02	Macomb and Dix from Elk Lake	14.3	11.5	5380	83	Wonderful views and slide climbing, three trail-less peaks and the grand views from Dix
GW07	Rocky Peak Ridge & Giant from 9N	18.4	13	6840	71	Long, very challenging, quiet loop to wonderful mountains using an unestablished trail-less route that may not be passable during high water
UW01	Indian Pass and MacNaughton	18.4	13	5110	98	A very long, challenging, but interesting loop that visits Indian Pass, and trail-less MacNaughton
KV09	Lower Great Range via Slide	19.1	14	7180	20	Extremely long intense hike with 6 major peaks, lovely streams and a trail-less ascent via a slide
